### St John's/Midsummer Celebrations – 24<sup>th</sup> June 1-3pm

Midsummer entices us to dream with its long warm sunny days, blossoms and sweet scents. But there is always the danger of getting lost in this - as you will see in Class 7/8's production of 'A Midsummer Night's Dream'. It delightfully illustrates how Fairyland makes mockery of us humans when we lose ourselves in the joys of summer. The celebration of St John's (24<sup>th</sup> June), a few days after the Summer Solstice, calls us back from dreaminess to address what is important – both in ourselves and in the world around us. Part of this celebration involves the purifying, transformative power of fire. Fire rituals have been associated with Midsummer since ancient times: fires were jumped and cattle driven through the dying embers.
